The Cayle Chernin Award is an annual cash prize of \$1000.00 intended to support an emerging or transitioning female artist's creation, development or production of a new work for the Theatre. The award will be presented by **Collette Micks** (last year's winner in film, television and media) and our three finalists are: **Kat Sandler, Susanna Fournier and Natasha Greenblatt.**

This year our special guests will include: actor/singer **Bryn McAuley**, stand-up comedian/actor **Aaron Berg** and the event will be hosted by the inimitable **Mr. David Gale.**

The Cayle Chernin Award is made possible by the generosity of Cayle's loving and supportive Colleagues, Friends and Family. This award honours the creative energy and nurturing spirit of actress/documentary filmmaker, teacher and mentor Cayle Chernin who was hard wired to tell stories.

Canadian Cayle Chernin, co-star of Don Shebib's classic film *Goin' Down the Road* and it's acclaimed sequel *Down The Road Again* passed away on February 18, 2011. She was known for her talent, generosity, imagination, intellect and incredible smile. Cayle was also valued for her commitment to women's issues and she was elected to ACTRA Toronto council, co-chaired the Toronto ACTRA Women's Committee and sat on the board of Equity Showcase Theatre. Cayle believed in life-long learning and her career spanned four decades in film and on stage developing new works, and encouraging up and coming artists.
